Phil Roberts started the presentation with introductions of consultant staff, Jeff Bodoh, City of New London and Casey Beyersdorf of Waupaca County.

The project highlights were given in a power point presentation which is attached. The presentation followed the information given in the attached project handout.

The proposed typical sections and plan/profiles were available for viewing. Approximately 16 residents attended the meeting according to the attached attendance list.

General Question and Answer Session (response is in red type and italicized)

Why do we need sidewalk (between Beckert and Oak) and why can't the sidewalk on the east side of the street?

It was decided to add new sidewalk on the west side because the two schools and a day care center on the project are on the west side.

Will residents be required to replace their sanitary laterals?

Jeff indicated the City will be replacing the sanitary laterals from the main to the R/W line if they are not PVC. The City will not require residents to replace the lateral from their house to the R/W line. Although, residents may want to consider it at this time. The lateral replacement is assessable. If a property owner wants to have their lateral replaced between the right of way and the house, they can contact the City about doing a special assessment.

When will the County be milling & overlaying the pavement on the south section?

Casey indicated the County plans to mill this when the reconstructed sections are ready for the upper layer of asphalt. So the residents in that area will be driving on the milled surface for only a short time.

2. One on One Session

A resident asked if the trees in the terrace will be removed?

The city plans to hire an arborist to review the terrace trees and make a recommendation based on the health of the tree.

The day care center director asked if they would need to remove their planter for the new sidewalk?

The planter will need to be removed either by the property owner or with permission the County could remove it when they are excavating for the new sidewalk.

The resident at 1410 Division St asked if they could get a second driveway approach?

The City and County have a permit process that needs to be followed.
