Details: Residents of the New London area are invited to attend an informational meeting about sex offenders at the Washington Center Community Room on Wednesday, February 11 at 5:30 p.m. The one-hour meeting is being presented by the New London Police Department and the Department of Corrections.

A registry specialist for the Department of Corrections will present a history of sex offender laws, how Wisconsin compares to other states, what the current law is, sanctions for non-compliance, and how citizens can help prevent negative incidents with registrants.

The New London Police Department will explain their sex offender accountability program, and some of their history working with registrants.

The meeting will also show attendees how to access information on the internet to learn more about registered sex offenders in their community, and how to use those resources to receive electronic updates about local offenders.

There are currently 15 registered sex offenders living in New London, according to www.familywatchdog.us.
