



Your new recycling hauler will begin collection on either Wednesday, May 6th or Friday, May 8th for the City of New London residents. (see map)

Recyclables will be picked up bi-weekly (every other Wednesday and Friday).

Recycling program reminders:

- Please have your recyclables placed at the curb the night before, or by 6:00 a.m. on your day of pick up. Due to a new hauler, your pick up time of day may be different.
- Please continue to separate your recyclables as you have in the past. One container for mixed paper (magazines, cardboard, box board, junk mail) - One container for commingle (plastic, tin, glass and aluminum). Please do not place recyclables in plastic bags, including shredded paper.
- Cardboard should be flat and no larger than 3' x 3' in size. Pizza boxes are not accepted.
- Not all plastic is recyclable. Please be sure the symbol on the container is #1 or #2. Engine oil bottles and ice cream pails are not accepted.
- Be sure recycling containers are placed at least 4 ft away from trash containers and secured on windy days.
- Please place recycling stickers on your recycling containers. This program is for residents only.
